Denester / Parts Puller

Reports to: Shop Manager

Classification: Non-Exempt (Hourly)

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Remove metal parts from laser cut steel remnants
- Operate power grinders/tools, drill press, belt sander, tapping table and other miscellaneous hand tools
- Perform basic metal fabrication tasks including deburring, tapping, and preparing metal parts for future fabrication steps
- Ability to work safely
- Wipe down, sweep, clean equipment, tools and work area
- Operate forklift and understand its safe working limits (if age permits)
- Record an accurate log of job times and labor reporting using shop computers

Job Skills & Qualifications

- Ability to read and write in English to process paperwork and follow up on any actions necessary
- Ability to read and accurately use measuring tools to identify parts by part number, measurements, and material grade
- Ability to read basic blueprints
- Ability to accept work instruction and communicate effectively with others
- Vision must be good or corrected to normal to perform normal job duties
- Show a positive and eager to learn attitude with strong work ethic

Physical Demands

- Stand continuously (8-12 hours)
- Walk, Ladder Climb-occasionally
- Sit, crawl-rarely
- Bend, twist, kneel or crouch-frequently
- Balance-frequently
- Firm grasp continuously
- Lift, push & pull up to 50 lbs-continuously and occasionally more than 50 lbs.
